

Debit Card & Ticketing

This is a combination of add-on modules to the AEK Membership Management system. The Debit component permits balances on file to be used by the customer over a period of time. The Ticket component creates the desired tickets or cards and uses Debit Card to determine their validity when scanned.

Features

This system allows a customer to buy value, such as one or more entries into a facility, play(s) or cash value. The transaction is rung through the AEK Cash Register and the sale is recorded. The value is stored in the customer's AEK Membership record for use with an AEK Universal Card, or a ticket is printed with a bar code and given to the customer.

The customer takes the ticket and, now or later, uses it to access the facility, to enter to play, or to use cash value by swiping the Universal Card or ticket through a bar code reader. The reader checks with the membership record to see if value exists, reduces the value according to the type of use, and reports the result to the cash register. This results in access granted via screen, turnstile opening, or printed daily use ticket. Gift value on cards or gift tickets may be used the same way. Multiple Pass Cards or tickets may be used instead of single use tickets. Group sales of debit value or tickets also may be processed.

Parameters are user-definable. By creating various user-defined types of Debit Card or Tickets, value could be for single or multiple use of specific value, for a dollar value which is reduced in varying amounts, for specific dates, any date, or season, and for a specific facility/use or general use. The original creation of a debit card or ticket value could result in creation of daily use tickets or passes upon redemption.

This system is retaining the value on-line according to a unique account within the system. The Universal Card or printed ticket held by the customer is *only* valid if the computer record concurs. Lost or stolen cards or ticket stock have no value until the record is created in the computer. The value remains only as long as parameters are met and until the value is reduced by use. This provides extraordinary control beyond conventional card and ticket methods.
